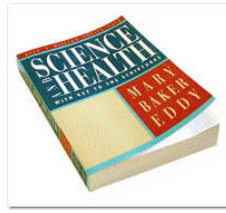

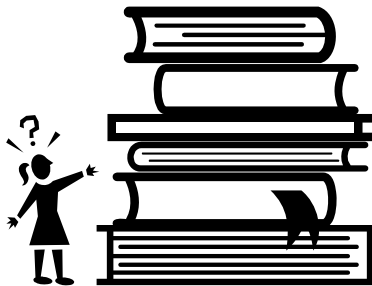

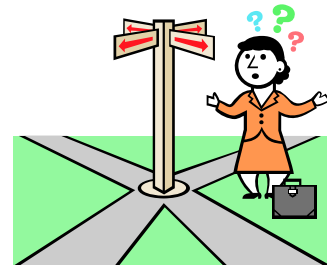
I will say of the Lord,
